zStandards-Aligned Units of Instruction

- Learning Targets will be directly aligned to the standards and posted each day along with being referenced throughout each lesson
- Teachers will use a standard lesson plan template and have lesson plans available/viewable on their desks
- Teachers will work in Data Teams to create Common Formative Assessments (CFA) that are directly aligned with content standards.
- Teachers will post Higher Order Thinking questions (HOT Questions) each day and use them to guide classroom instruction and learning.

Attend to Students' Emotional States and Provide Resources

- BMS will reestablish Character Education program
- Teachers will be provided relationship building strategies and will receive continual professional development to support relationships with students and parents
- Students will be identified and recommended for mentor programs through our community partners
- Partner with Elon Honors Institute to provide students with education on understanding and acceptance.
- Increase number of clubs available to students
- Administration will have daily "check-ins" with designated students.

Tiered Instructional System to Meets Needs of All Students

- Students will receive a 50 minute Literacy Block (American Reading Company) every day.
- Champions Academy - partnership with Ebenezer Church to provide interventions for 6th grade students.
- Encore tutoring program - after school tutoring to provide interventions for 7th and 8th grade students.
- BMS will bring in Elon tutors during the Elective time periods to provide interventions for select students based on standardized data and CFA data.
- Students will be identified through data collection to receive intervention time with Mr. Gerringer.
- Students will be identified through data collection to also receive support with our Reading and Math Interventionists.
