

1. SERVICE HOURS

- Members should use the service hour form on the NHS webpage. Likewise, if the place at which you are completing the service hours gives you a certificate, that can count as well. Give all hours to the officers; you may also send them to Mr. Peters. Please have these hours turned in by the end of the school year.
