

1. DUES

- Dues will be \$20 this year. This includes the price of a T-shirt. Please make all checks payable to “EHS” and in the memo box put (NHS dues). Also, if you pay cash, please bring exact change. I will begin collecting dues starting hopefully tomorrow. You must get any money to me before 9:50 on any given school day. I WILL NOT COLLECT ANY MONEY AFTER FIRST PERIOD—NO EXCEPTIONS!
- **Dues need to be turned in no later than October 1, 2021.**

2. LETTER OF RESPONSIBILITY

- You will need to complete another Letter of Responsibility.
- **All letters must be turned in by the same date as dues (October 1, 2021).**

3. NHS YEARLY REQUIREMENTS

- You are expected to earn twenty service project hours throughout the year, submitting the service hour form you can find on EA’s NHS website. You will also participate in the two yearly service projects, both of which will require five service hours. The service hours earned in these projects do not count towards the yearly total.
- Attend all meetings.
- Maintain a 3.25 unweighted and 3.5 weighted GPA

4. NHS INDUCTIONS

- We are currently planning on inductions in December or January, Covid-permitting.
- Any senior member who wishes to be formally inducted in this ceremony is welcome to participate. However, if you do not wish to walk across the stage, that is fine, too. New members will all be inducted formally.
- Guests will need to be limited.
- Once the date for inductions is settled, I will communicate it to you. The expectation is that all members help and, at the least, attend inductions.

5. NHS APPLICATION PERIOD

- So you are aware, we will be accepting applications throughout October, with the aim to have decisions sometime at the end of November, likely when we return from Thanksgiving break.
- Applicants must demonstrate
 - i. That they have the minimum required GPA: 3.25 weighted, 3.5 weighted.
 - ii. That they have participated in service hours: 10 total required
 - iii. That they have demonstrated leadership: 1 position needed since entering high school, either in the school or community
 - iv. That they have strong character: 3 recommendations needed, two from school (1 from a core) and one from the community
- We will be inviting all who qualify academically to interest meetings during Eagle time in the coming weeks. We may also hold a before- or after-school interest meeting, too.
