- New high school constructed in Hawfields vicinity to eliminate current overcapacity issues at Southern High and Eastern High

- Close Pleasant Grove; construct new elementary school to include students from PGE, and some from Yoder & S Mebane attendance zones
- New Elon Elementary/middle school combination

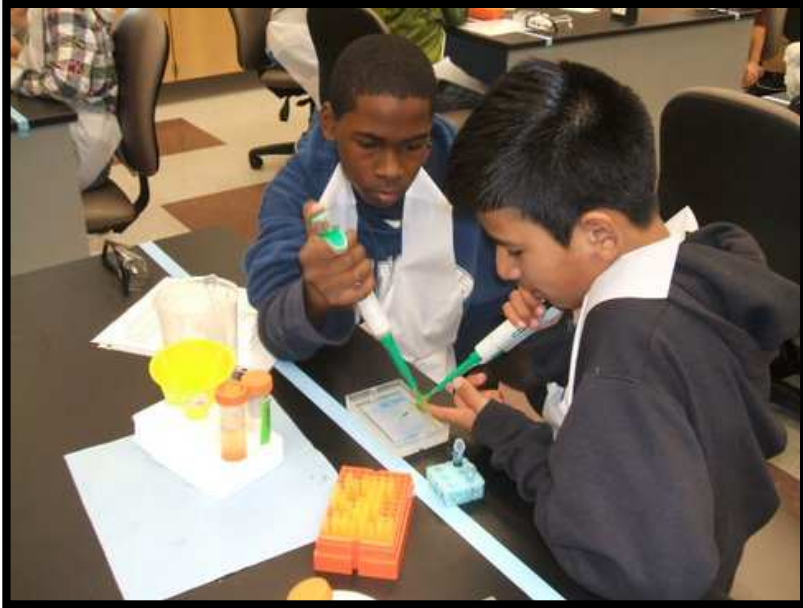
