

# Modifications

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The Alamance Burlington School System requires all students to participate in the Capstone Project. Modifications will be made for students in the Exceptional Children, Limited English Proficient, and Section 504 divisions as needed, according to state and federal guidelines.

Examples of modifications:

- Modified scoring of all components based on the student's capabilities
- Allowing students in these categories to make their presentation without having met "total score" on the Product and Portfolio components
- Alternative portfolio and presentation for OCS students

## **Transfer Students -**

Students sometimes transfer during their senior year. Circumstances of their transfer could clearly affect their ability to complete a part or all of the Capstone Project. Because of this, modifications will be made to allow the student to complete the Capstone Project.

Examples of modifications:

- Modified requirements for students transferring after January 1 of their graduation year:
  - Suggested 10 hour minimum product hours
  - Three exemplars included in the portfolio
- Modified requirements for students transferring prior to January 1 of their graduation year:
  - No modifications needed unless the situation merits; determined by each school

For students transferring within the Alamance Burlington School System, it will be necessary for guidance counselors to provide all Capstone materials specific to the student. These documents may be given to the student or sent to the school the student is transferring to. Any documents saved in Goggle, should be available in any ABSS school.
