Dear Parent/Guardian:

At the end of May, End-of-Grade (EOG) tests in Mathematics and English Language Arts will begin in the elementary schools. End-of-Grade tests in Mathematics and English Language Arts will be administered to all students in 3rd – 8th grades, and the End-of-Grade test in Science will be administered to students in 5th and 8th grade. Students and teachers have faced a variety of new situations and have worked very hard this year.

The new End of Grade English Language Arts test will be going through a standard setting process this summer. As a result, those scores will be delayed. Due to the necessity of the critical processes to validate scores, students will not receive their EOG Reading test scores at the completion of the test administration. Instead, the scores for these tests will be delayed until August 2021 once the SBE has provided approval. After the SBE approval, schools will provide parents with each student's Individual Student Report.

The elementary testing schedule is as follows for fourth and fifth grade students (though some individuals may have slight variations as communicated by their school):

#### Fourth Grade:

- Tue, May 25: EOG Reading (scores will be delayed)
- Wed, May 26: EOG Math

#### Fifth Grade:

- Fri, May 21: EOG Science
- Mon, May 24: EOG Math
- Tue, May 25: EOG Reading (scores will be delayed)
