TECHNOLOGY

Garrett has a 1-1 student to device ratio. CURRICULUM

The curriculum is based on the Common Core and the North Carolina Essential Standards. Our reading and math instruction is based on the ABSS ELA Literacy and Math Framework. We support our core curriculum with a dedicated professional staff for Exceptional Children, English Language Learners and Academically Gifted Students, along with support teachers for science, math and literacy intervention. Our Encore courses are 45 minutes daily and include Physical Education, Art, Media and Music.

STUDENT SUPPORT & CHARACTER EDUCATION

Garrett uses the "MTSS: Multi-Tier System of Support", also known as the Response to Intervention (RTI) process to identify students having problems as early as possible and provide them with the interventions they need to succeed behaviorally and academically. The character education program at Garrett is based on Gators ROCK! All our students know that when we ROCK, we are Responsible, we respect Others, we use self-Control and we show Kindness. Garrett staff and students work together to recognize and reward students who ROCK.!
