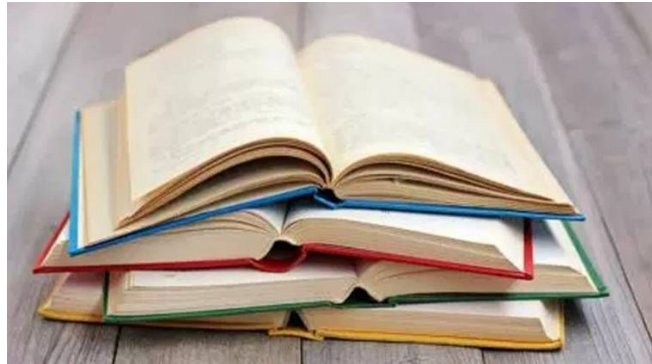

Olympic Summer School

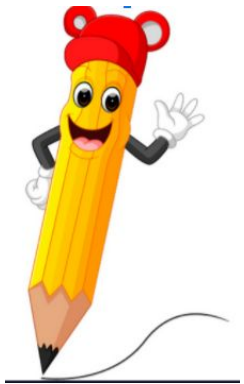
To add an element of fun, we will all become **Olympic Learners** this summer!

Procedures



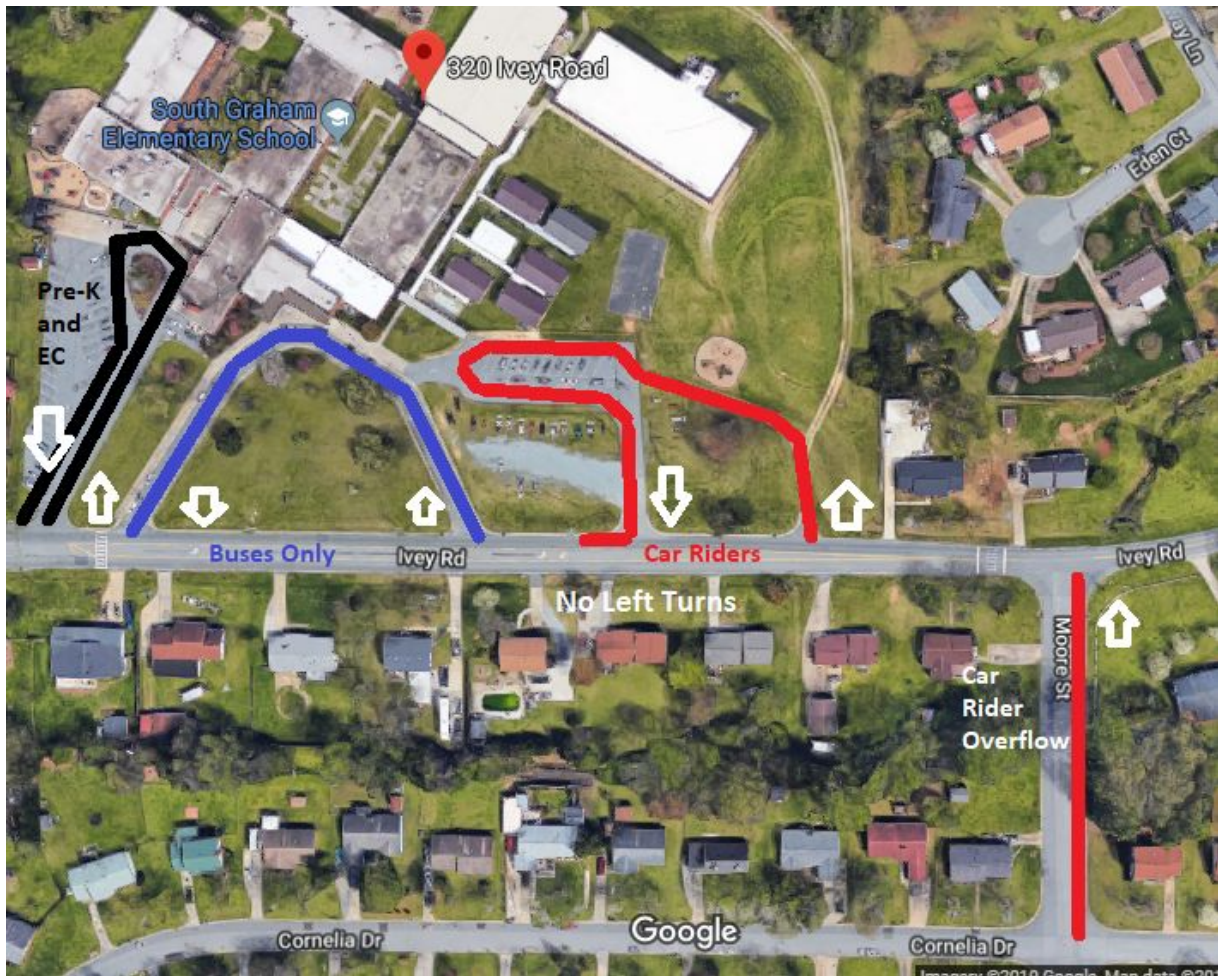
School Day: 7:45-3:45

Buses: Once we receive bus routes, I will share this information with parents. If you did not request bus transportation on your application, then we will not be able to add your student to the route. Buses will unload and load in the front circle.

Car Riders: We will open our doors at 7:30. Cars will line up by the side entrance, using the same procedure as during the school year. Dismissal will begin at 3:45.

Safety: In order to keep everyone safe and healthy, students and staff will be required to wear masks. We will have a custodian and sanitation specialist who will make sure that the building is clean and virus-free. At this time the building will remain closed to visitors.

Meals: Students will be provided breakfast and lunch each day. They will eat in their classrooms for both meals.
