# What is ACPL Connect?

ACPL Connect is the result of Alamance
County Public Libraries working together with Alamance County schools to provide students with easily accessible information and educational resources.

Students no longer need library cards. Instead, students can use their **school ID** to access library services.

The default PIN is the last 4 digits of the student ID number.

Borrow up to 10 print or audio books, including DVDs and music CDs
