As you are well aware, End Of Grade tests for 3rd grade is scheduled for May 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>. Our 5th graders will take the Science EOG on May 31<sup>st</sup> as well and then 4th and 5th graders will take the Reading and Math EOGs on June 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.
