Sealed proposals will be released on or after **September 2, 2020** and received by the Alamance-Burlington School System Board of Education until **2:00 PM on September 30, 2020**, at the Administrative Office located at 1712 Vaughn Road, Burlington, NC 27217-2916, and thereafter publicly opened and read aloud, for the re-bid to furnish all materials and labor for SECURITY UPGRADES to the GROVE PARK ELEMENTARY, 141 Trail One, Burlington, NC 27215-5531. Address Bids to the attention of Dr. Todd Thorpe. Prior prequalification requirements are being waived for this bid event.

Copies of plans, specifications, and contract documents are available for inspection during business hours until bids are opened at the following locations: Administrative Office, 1712 Vaughn Road, Burlington, NC 27217-2916. A \$50.00 bid deposit is required to obtain a complete set of electronic PDF plans and specifications, made payable to McKissick Associates Architects. The full deposit will be refundable to contractors submitting a Bona Fide bid.

A 5% Bid Bond is required for this project. Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds will be required. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 60 days.

A brief description of work in the project follows:

- A. The work of this project involves renovation of receptionist space to add a secure vestibule. Interior work will include a new reception counter & casework, interior finishes and reworking of the existing HVAC & Electrical systems. Exterior work will involve creating a new entrance into the building along with a canopy and sidewalks. A concrete stair and ramp will also be constructed to create an accessible route to the main level. Limited asbestos tile removal and flooring replacement in existing office areas will also be an alternate.

A non-mandatory prebid meeting will be held at the school site listed above, outside the main lobby, at **2:00 PM, Wednesday September 9th, 2020**.

Minority businesses are encouraged to submit bids for this project. The Board of Education awards public contracts without regard to race, religion, color, creed, national origin, sex, age or handicapped condition as defined by North Carolina General Statutes, Section 168A-3. The appropriate forms from the section entitled “00 43 39 Minority Business Participation” must be submitted with each bid to show good faith efforts to obtain Minority and Women Owned Business Enterprise participation.

The Alamance-Burlington Schools Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids presented and to waive any informalities and irregularities.
