







Read to Achieve

- Final decisions are still being made at the state level regarding the standard-setting process for ELA/Reading EOGs and how that impacts known proficiency at the end of the year.

- However, the current opportunities for meeting the requirements of Read to Achieve are as follows:
 - 1. BOG
 - 2. iStation (at any point in the year up to the last 10 days across multiple opportunities) I Station
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


Read to Achieve

- 3. Achieve3000 (at any point in the year up to the last 10 days across multiple opportunities) Achieve 3000
 - 4. Imagine Learning - Reading Level Assessment (at any point in the year up to the last 10 days across multiple opportunities) Imagine Literacy

- 5. EOG
 - 6. Read to Achieve Test
 - 7. Summer Reading Camp with iStation, Achieve3000, and/or Imagine Learning
 - 8. Summer Reading Camp Read to Achieve Test

I Station

- Tracks students progress throughout the year.
 - Provides an overall snapshot of reading ability.
 - Engages students in an animated game like activities.
 - Focuses on:
 - Phonological and Phonemic awareness (rhyme; initial, middle and final sounds; segmenting and blending sounds)
 - Phonics (letter knowledge, alphabetic decoding, spelling)
 - Vocabulary (academic words in the language)
 - Comprehension (listening/language comprehension, reading comprehension)
 - Fluency (accuracy and rate, monitoring for comprehension)
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Achieve 3000
