State Grading Policy

Look at your Q3 Grade

Will it improve your GPA? Use it!
Contact your teacher if you want to improve this grade.
Select the Traditional Numerical Grade option to calculate it into your GPA.

Are you passing but your grade will negatively affect your GPA in the long range of your high school career? Choose the PC-19 option. This will give you class credit but will not affect your GPA!

If you are not passing CONTACT your teacher as there is still time to fix this!
You can get content recovery before you choose a WC-19 and have to repeat the course.

Year Long Classes

S1 Grade and S2 Grade will count as separate grades and will count as .5 credit each.

Look at your S1 Grade

You will get a numerical grade for S1 and it will count in your GPA.

If you want to improve this grade contact your teacher.

Note If your F1 grade is higher than your S1 grade you will get the higher score.

Look at your Q3, S2, and F1 Grades

Focus on the higher of the three (Q3 vs S2 vs F1)

Will it improve your GPA? Use it! Select the **Traditional Numerical Grade** option to calculate it into your GPA.
