

Size:

- Tall
- Lengthy
- Large body capacity
- Good spring of ribs
- Wide at pin bones

Dairy Character

- Walking upwards
- Trim and feminine head and neck
- Angular over hips, withers, pins
- Carrying minimal extra fat
- Level from hips to pins

Udder:


- Smooth fore udder attachment
- High and wide rear udder attachment
- Evenly divided udder quarters
- Desirable sized and shaped teats
- Carried above hocks

1. **Slender** (desirable) - Udder is attached from 25 to 28 inches (very good) to 21 to 24 inches (poor)

2. **Close** (undesirable) - Udder is attached from 18 to 21 inches (very poor) to 15 to 18 inches (poor)


3. **Wide** (undesirable) - Udder is attached from 12 to 15 inches (very poor) to 10 to 12 inches (poor)

4. Foot and shape (angle) points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely steep angle 99 to extremely low angle 50 points.

Extremely Pointy Right Set Hook Extremely Stiffed

5. Hook and (low) heel points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely hooked 99 to extremely low 50 points.

6. Forefoot angle points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - severe slope from hooks to pins 99 to pins clearly higher than hooks 50 points.

Extremely Narrow Intermediate Width Extremely Wide

7. Udder width points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely wide 99 to extremely narrow 50 points.

8. Fore teat attachment points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely tight attachment 99 to extremely broken 50 points.

9. Udder height (to attachment) points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely high 99 to extremely low 50 points.

10. Fore teat attachment points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely tight attachment 99 to extremely low 50 points.

11. Teat placement (low view) points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely wide placement 99 to extremely close 50 points.

12. Suspensory ligament (cleft) points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extreme cleft 99 to broken 50 points.

Extremely Deep Udder Floor at Hook Extremely Shallow

13. Udder depth (relative to point of hook) points are awarded from 99 to 50 points - extremely shallow, udder floor well above hook 99 to extremely deep 50 points.

Computing Placing Scores

- 1. Compare placings to official placings

- 3. Use the cuts to calculate points
- 4. Total the points of all pairs
- 5. Subtract total from 50 to find your score
