



Targets

Reading: Ask & answer questions about details in a text, main idea, characters, setting, author, illustrator, problem (conflict), solution (resolution), concepts about print, fluency

Language Arts: Rhyming, Syllables in words (table =ta-ble has 2 syllables), l to l correspondence when reading (pointing to each word as you read)

Recognize, name, and produce sounds for the following letters: Oo, Gg, Dd, Ss, Ee, Uu, Ll, Hh (review Mm, Nn, Bb, Ff, Tt, Cc, Ii, Rr, Aa)

Sight words: my, the, go, we, at, be, what

Math: measurement (heavier, lighter, longer, shorter), numbers 0-20 (writing counting, and recognizing and focusing on teen numbers), ten frames, patterns, and ordering numbers, shapes

Writing: drawing a detailed picture and writing a simple sentence, punctuation, capitalization, spacing, writing left-to-right, matching writing to drawing, beginning to use letter sounds to write unknown words, spelling sight words correctly

Science: Weather, Fall, Pumpkins, Nocturnal Animals, Fire Safety
