Math:

- Potter won a grant for Reflex Math, which is a math fact fluency website, addition/subtraction and multiplication/division. It was for 35 seats. She has spoken with each grade level and gotten the names of students who may benefit most from this. All seats are presently filled, but students can be exchanged as mastery is either reached or teachers feel they are not utilizing the program to the fullest. The requirements of the grant are that the students are on the program for at least 15 minutes, 3 times a week. If these requirements are met, we can list Reflex math as an intervention, as only a small selection of students will be using it.
