I. Greetings, Announcements, General Celebrations, Attendance

- Parnell... what does everyone think our Literacy goal for K-3 should be set at, considering Atlas materials that are perhaps more rigorous? We discussed the rigor of various questions, the scoring of reports, the TRC goals. Our growth for last year improved from 44% to 48% (a change in 14%). This year, we are starting around 47%. 16/17 and 17/18 we have finished at 58%. Over the next two years, we would like to see our goal hit 68%, which would get us over the 14% hump. We are dropping 2% off our original goal.
