- _____ 18. Gives us the right to confront our accusers when charged with a criminal offense.
- _____ 19. Prohibits being forced to give testimony that might implicate oneself in a crime.

- _____ 20. . A State may not be sued in federal court by residents of another State or by foreign residents.

- _____ 25. States that the people of the United States retain certain unenumerated rights that cannot be taken away.

- _____ 27. Protects freedom of religion and speech.
- _____ 28. Gives right to bear arms.
- _____ 29. Entitles the accused to a grand jury indictment in all capital cases.
- _____ 30. Guarantees the rights of all citizens born or naturalized in the U.S.
